



## 2019 Willamette Valley Pinot Gris

Torii Mor's 2019 Pinot Gris displays a light golden color, a rich forward aroma of ripe bananas, green apples with notes of grassiness. The flavors show a bright, refreshing acidity, with light sweetness and rich fruity notes of both green and ripe; bananas and apples finishing with grassy notes reminiscent of New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. The wine texture is juicy, semirich and mouth-filling. The finish is bright, with a mineralysavory long finish. This Pinot Gris will be a great food pairing to seafood in general, and fat rich seafood, like salmon and steelhead in particular. This Pinot Gris is ready to drink now.
